If during the course of the meeting covered by this notice the Board should determine that a closed meeting or session should be held or is required in relation to any item presented to the Board in this agenda, then such Closed Meeting or Session as authorized by Chapter 551, Texas Government Code (the Open Meetings Law) will be held by the Board at that date, hour, and place given in this notice as the Board may conveniently meet in such Closed Meeting or Session concerning any and all subjects and all purposes permitted by Chapter 551, Texas Government Code of said Open Meetings Law including the following sections and purposes:

*Section 551.071 *Consultation with District's Attorney on a matter in which the duty of the attorney to the Board conflicts with Texas Government Code Chapter 551.*

*Section 551.072 *Real Estate - Consideration of Purchase or Exchange of Real Property.*

*Section 551.074 *Personnel - Duties of Public Officers and/or Employees – Resignation and/or Employment*

*Section 551.082 *Student Discipline*

*Section 551.0821 *Personally identifiable information about Public School Student*

C. Open Session

The Board of Trustees will consider action on Closed Session items as listed.

D. Open Forum - Public Comments – Policy BED

A maximum of thirty (30) minutes is set aside to allow the public to make comments to the board. People wishing to participate must sign up with the presiding officer or designee before the meeting begins and indicate the topic about which they wish to speak. Individuals are limited to 5 minutes and delegations of more than five persons shall appoint one person to present their views before the board.

Complaints and concerns for which other resolution channels are provided shall be directed through those channels before bringing the matter to the board.

If information is presented which causes the Board to consider the appointment, employment, evaluation, reassignment, duties, discipline or dismissal of a public officer or employee, or to hear complaints or charges against a public officer or employee, the Board may recess to Closed Session, in accord with the Provisions of Chapter 551.074, Texas Government Code.

The Board may not deliberate or decide regarding any subject that is not included on the agenda.
