The North Central Texas College Foundation Scholarship Program is designed to attract outstanding students based on academic achievement, leadership qualities, character, and financial need. This application form is used for all internally funded general, NCTC Foundation, and Departmental scholarships. Students wishing to apply for any externally funded scholarships must submit the proper applications. Applications and information are available in the NCTC Financial Aid and Foundation Offices.

READ ALL GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE SUBMITTING APPLICATION:

1. Complete all sections of the application. **Incomplete applications will not be considered.**
2. Submit scholarship application and all supporting materials no later than **April 15** for the fall semester and **October 15** for the spring semester.
3. **High school seniors must attach an official transcript that includes grades, class ranking, and ACT or SAT scores.**
4. **Currently enrolled college students must attach an official transcript of all college course work completed as of the date of application.**
5. Rating of scholarship applications are based on **GPA, extracurricular activities, honors received, and leadership and community service. Applicants should list ALL honors and activities from high school, college, community, church and employment.**
6. Applicants are encouraged to submit letters of recommendation with their application.
7. Applicants must be eligible for admission to NCTC in accordance with existing policies detailed in the current *General Catalog*.
8. Recipients must fulfill and maintain the grade point requirements of the scholarship for which application is being made.
