



NORTH CENTRAL TEXAS COLLEGE AGRICULTURE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The Agriculture Department of North Central Texas College at Gainesville, Texas awards several agriculture scholarships each semester as part of the Friends of Agriculture Scholarship Awards Program (FASAP). These scholarships provide students with a \$500.00 award for each semester of enrollment.

The scholarship is intended to recognize Agriculture students which possess outstanding leadership qualities, communication skills, notable personal character and those who demonstrate active community involvement.

This application form is used only for the FASAP Agriculture Scholarship. Students wishing to apply for NCTC general, foundation or other departmental scholarships must submit the proper applications.

1. Complete all sections of the application. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
2. FASAP Agriculture scholarship applications are accepted anytime throughout the year, however, priority is given to those applicants who apply no later than April 15 for the fall semester and October 15 for the spring semester.
3. High school seniors must attach an official high school transcript.
4. Currently enrolled college students must attach an official transcript of all college course work completed as of the date of application.
5. Submit letters of recommendation, portfolios or any other materials you would like to be considered along with your application.
6. Scholarship funds may not be applied towards classes taken as dual credit.

Other guidelines and restrictions of the FASAP Agriculture scholarship:

1. Value of the scholarship will be \$500.00 per semester to be used as payment on tuition and registration charges.
2. Recipients must major and be enrolled in agriculture or an agriculture related field at North Central Texas College.
3. Recipients must be enrolled in a minimum of 5 credit hours of Agriculture courses each semester. (*Agriculture Courses include Horticulture and Equine*)
4. Recipients must maintain a minimum 2.0 grade point average while completing a minimum of twelve (12) hours each semester.
5. Class attendance and participation are essential, and records will be monitored.
6. Student's transcripts/files will be reviewed and discussed for further scholarship considerations each semester.
7. To receive and remain eligible for the scholarships, students must meet with Steve Keith, Chairman of the Agriculture Department, each semester prior to early registration or regular registration to have their schedule of classes approved.
8. If for any reason a scholarship recipient withdraws or drops out of college during the semester, they are required to REPAY the scholarship award.
